## "Panther Pride" Battalion Uniform and Discipline Policy

- 1. I understand that the uniform and equipment issued to me is my sole responsibility to secure and keep clean and serviceable. I understand that a hold will be placed on my academic records should I have an outstanding debt to JROTC. I understand this uniform is property of the Federal Government and recognize that there are legal means the government can take to recover the losses should I not return the uniform or if it is loss, damaged or stolen. I recognize the value of this uniform is approximately \$230.00.
- 2. I recognize that each Wednesday, I must wear the uniform to school for the entire day. I understand that only my JROTC instructor can excuse me in advance if I have a legitimate reason. I agree to wear the uniform on the following Thursday should I have an approved excused absence on the uniform day. I realize that if I fail to wear the uniform, it may result in a failing grade for the six weeks.
- 3. I understand that while wearing the uniform, I must conduct myself as a lady or gentleman and display my best behavior. I will wear the uniform properly at all times including wearing the garrison cap outdoors. I will not partially undress from the uniform until I reach home. I recognize that improper wear or refusal to wear the uniform is grounds for having my uniform rights revoked and possible removal from the program.
- 4. I will not wear the uniform to any demonstration, political rally, picket lines, court action, extremist organization meeting or any activity that would bring discredit to the U.S. Army.
- 5. I recognize that each Friday is physical training day and that I should dress appropriately (PT Uniform). I will not wear flip flops, high heel shoes, dresses, dress shoes or any other clothing which could impede on my ability to participate in PT.
- 6. As a cadet, I realize that both JROTC instructors and other cadets will teach me throughout the year. I will obey their commands and perform the assigned tasks to the best of my abilities. If a cadet gives me a command that I believe is unlawful, I will immediately notify a JROTC instructor and will not carry out the order. I understand that push-ups are a form of mental and physical training used in the program for motivating cadets to reach their full potential and can only be given by the JROTC instructors for corrective action.
- 7. I realize that my JROTC grade is influenced by many factors including wearing of the uniform, participation and academic tests. I will refer to the cadet handbook for more details on this topic.
